




$$\frac{120,000 \text{ kBtus}}{3,000 \text{ sf}} = 40 \text{ EUI}$$


Buffalo double – thermostat turned down





Forward-Looking Infrared Image (FLIR)



What does it mean to embody my research question?




Why an arts-based research method?
